



KKH: NEUROPLASTIQUE/SOUNDSCAPES

EXPERIMENTAL MULTICHANNEL SOUND WORKSHOP - Royal Institute of Art (KKH) Stockholm, Sweden. 2016

Visiting Professor: Stephen Schaum (US)

CLASS DESCRIPTION

This workshop is a ten class exploration of digital sound recording, production, composition and spatialization techniques using Audacity, Max/MSP, Protools, and Reaper. Throughout the workshop we will also construct our own homemade contact mics, pre amps, binaural mics, op amps, Cornu spiral speakers, and become familiar with standard field recording hardware such as the Edirol r-44 and Zoom H4n and H5.

Focussing on multi-channel/spatialized sound environments and performance, we will investigate and experiment with the visceral neurophysiology behind sonic and spatial perception, aleatoric composition techniques, field recording, microtonal synthesis, basic psychoacoustics, and listen to some significant experimental sonic compositions of the 20th century as we compose our own. Most of all we will explore the power of sound to influence our state of mind, body and sense of space. Field trips to local sound studios and venues such as Elektronmusikstudion (EMS), Fylkingen, and Audiorama will be spaced throughout our time together, and a live public performance at the end of the workshop will be held on the evening of the last class at Audiorama, next to the Moderna Museet, using their 21 channel sound environment.

This workshop is an extension of previous workshops/studios held at Harvard University's Graduate School of Design, La Mama/Culturehub (NYC), and Seoul Institute of the Arts (Seoul, South Korea).

Stephen Schaum is an artist and researcher based in Brooklyn, NY working within the fields of sonic composition, installation, sculpture and neuroaesthetics. Recent exhibitions and performances include Harvard University, HOLO (NY, US), Knockdown Center (NY, US), Fridman Gallery (NY, US), Outpost (NY, US), Trans-Pecos(NY, US) Vanderbilt University, and at the Hudson Valley Center of Contemporary Art (NY, US).


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
